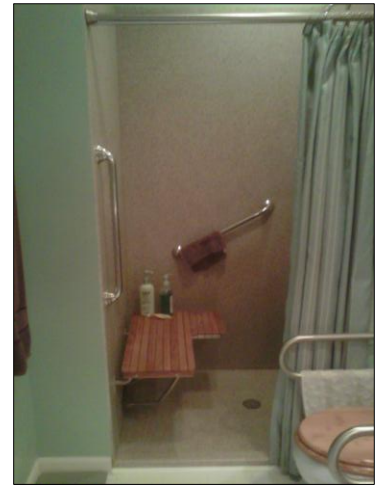

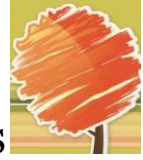


Accessible Kitchens
